OPEN ENROLLMENT January 17- February 3, 2023 @ 3:00pm



In order to request for your student to attend a school other than your school of residence but still within FJUHSD you must participate in Open Enrollment.



Open Enrollment and Registration are not the same. Open Enrollment is only if you do not want your student to attend your school of residence.



To participate in Open Enrollment you must go to your school of residence and fill out Open Enrollment paperwork. The cut off date for Open Enrollment is February 3, 2023 at 3:00pm.

OPEN ENROLLMENT FACTS



Students residing within the District and who are entering grades 9-12 during the 2023/24 year have an opportunity to apply to attend another District school other than the school of residence. Through this option, parents choose a school - not a program. Testing may be required for specialized programs. Visit the schools' website for testing information.

WHAT YOU NEED TO KNOW

WHERE TO APPLY Applications can <u>ONLY</u> be obtained in person at the school of residence. Applications cannot be mailed or emailed and will not be made available in advance.

WHAT TO BRING Parent/guardian(s) must provide proof of residency within the District at the time of application. A gas, water or electricity bill AND rental agreement/mortgage statement.

WHAT INFORMATION IS REQUIRED ON THE APPLICATION

The application mainly consists of basic demographic information about your student and is a quick process.

SCHOOL CHOICE You may apply for only 1 school. If more than 1 application is received for a student, both applications will be voided and student will attend the school of residence.

FREQUENTLY ASKED QUESTIONS

I do not reside within the District, can I apply?
No, you must be a resident of the Fulleton Joint Union High School District. If you are interested in attending one of our high schools, you may apply for an Interdistrict Transfer release from your district of residence.
What is the school of residence for my address?
The school name is contained in the top left corner of the mailing label on this flyer. If you did not receive a flyer or would like to confirm your address, visit: http://locator.decisioninsite.com/7StudyID=205959
Will my student be guaranteed acceptance into school of choice? No, acceptance is hased on the number of spaces. available at each school. Spaces are NOT based on a first-come.first-serve basis. A lottery system will be established if number of applications exceeds the number of spaces.

Is transportation provided? No, transportation is not provided.

Does Open Enrollment need to be renewed annually? No, it is valid for 4 years; HOWEVER a minimum attendance of 1 school year is required.
