Our eSports Team will be participating in a variety of games and competitions, providing students a chance to showcase their talents and dedication in a digital arena. - 1. Anonymous User Names and Gamer Profiles: Students will login to the league website with an anonymous username and profile. Their in game name will be displayed and is of their choosing. We encourage all students to use anonymous usernames or gamer profiles during gameplay. This not only protects their personal information but also fosters a sense of privacy and security.
- 2. Strict Code of Conduct: Our eSports Team will adhere to a comprehensive code of conduct that promotes respectful and responsible behavior. Any breach of this code will be dealt with promptly and appropriately.
- 3. Supervision and Monitoring: Please be aware that all interactions within the esports league chat are recorded and can be reviewed. This is to ensure a safe and inclusive environment for all participants. Our coaches and school staff will closely monitor these interactions to ensure that conversations are positive and respectful. Any inappropriate behavior will be addressed promptly.
